SPECIFICATIONS FOR CHOOSING TYPE OF COPYRIGHT

Every author of a doctoral thesis has some intellectual property rights that can be exercised in the manner it seems appropriate to defend their interests: retain copyright while allowing others to copy, distribute, and make some uses of their work, at least non-commercially. When authorize dissemination of the thesis through the consortial repository TDX and repository of UdG (DUGi) you can choose one of these ways:

1. **"All rights reserved"** (copyright). Anyone who wants to use the thesis eventually have to ask permission to the author, except in cases provided by the *Llei de propietat intel·lectual* -copyright law- (such as private copy or the citation right).

2. **Holding only a part of these rights by a Creative Commons (CC)**. It is a licensing system that allows the reproduction, distribution and public communication of the doctoral thesis, after an acknowledgement and recognizing the authorship. By choosing one of these licenses, the author allows certain uses without requiring a specific request. The application of these licenses is completely free and there is no registration of the doctoral thesis required in any specific place.

You can choose from the following licenses:

- Attribution (by): this license allows commercial use of the original work and possible derivative works; generation and distribution are also permitted without restriction.
- Attribution - NonCommercial (by-nc): this license allows others remix, tweak, and build upon your work non commercial. Original work can't be used with commercial purposes.
- Attribution - Noncommercial - Share Alike (by-nc-sa): this license does not allow commercial use of the original work and other derivative works; distribution must be under identical terms of the original work.
- Noncommercial - No Derivative Works (by-nc-nd): this license does not to allow commercial use of the original work and the generation of derivative works. This license is the most restrictive of all six licenses.
- Attribution - Share Alike (by-sa): this license allows others remix, tweak, and build upon your work even a commercial purpose; all new works based on yours will carry same licenses, so in derivative will also allow commercial use (this licenses is used by Wikipedia, and is recommended for materials that would benefit from incorporating content from wikipedia and similarly licensed projects).
- Attribution - No Derivative Works (by-nd): this license allows for redistribution, commercial and non-commercial, use of the original work, but not the generation of derivative Works.

On the Creative Commons website there is a tutorial program that facilitates the choice of the appropriate license to the interests of the author.

Choosing any of these possibilities by the author should be stated explicitly in the document of authorization, indicating one of the boxes arranged for this purpose.
