This talk, delivered in Spanish, with handouts in English, Spanish and Catalan, marks the centenary this year of the birth of the Catalan novelist, Mercè Rodoreda (1908-1983). A major figure in Catalan literature of the twentieth century, her style shows similarities with that of Virginia Woolf. Her novel of the Spanish Civil War, *La plaça del diamante* is possibly her best-known work.
