Doctor in Social Psychology from the Universidad Computense de Madrid. Associate Professor at the Universidad Rey Juan Carlos. He researches Science, Technology, and Gender, as well as teaching and epistemological innovation from a feminist perspective.

Doctor in Nanoscience and she is a Full Professor in the Department of Electronic and Biomedical Engineering at the Universitat de Barcelona. She is the director of the Gender Perspective and Feminisms Chair at the Universitat de Barcelona and former president of the "Associació de Dones Investigadores i Tecnòlogues de Catalunya" (AMIT).
