The European Commission hereby awards this Charter to:

Institution undertakes to respect the following principles:

ect in full the principles of non-discrimination set out in the Programme and ensure equal access and rtunities to mobile participants from all backgrounds.

re full recognition for satisfactorily completed activities of study mobility and, where possible, train- ings in terms of credits awarded (ECTS or compatible system). Ensure the inclusion of satisfactorily ileted study and / or traineeship mobility activities in the final record of student achievements (Diploma lement or equivalent).

je no fees, in the case of credit mobility, to incoming mobile students for tuition, registration, examina- or access to laboratory and library facilities.

stitution further undertakes to:

- When Participating in Mobility Activities - Before Mobility

sh and regularly update the course catalogue on the website of the Institution well in advance of the ity periods, so as to be transparent to all parties and allow mobile students to make well-informed es about the courses they will follow.

out mobility only within the framework of prior agreements between institutions. These agreements ilish the respective roles and responsibilities of the different parties, as well as their commitment to d quality criteria in the selection, preparation, reception and integration of mobile participants.

re that outgoing mobile participants are well prepared for the mobility, including having attained the isary level of linguistic proficiency.

re that student and staff mobility for education or training purposes is based on a learning agreement udents and a mobility agreement for staff validated in advance between the home and host institutions terprises and the mobile participants.

je assistance related to obtaining visas, when required, for incoming and outgoing mobile participants.

je assistance related to obtaining insurance, when required, for incoming and outgoing mobile participants.

je guidance to incoming mobile participants in finding accommodation.

During Mobility

re equal academic treatment and services for home students and staff and incoming mobile participants.

rate incoming mobile participants into the Institution's everyday life.

in place appropriate mentoring and support arrangements for mobile participants.

je appropriate linguistic support to incoming mobile participants.

After Mobility

+ Accept all activities indicated in the learning agreement as counting towards the degree, provided these have been satisfactorily completed by the mobile students.

+ Provide incoming mobile participants and their home institutions with transcripts containing a full, accurate and timely record of their achievements at the end of their mobility period.

+ Support the reintegration of mobile participants and give them the opportunity, upon return, to build on their experiences for the benefit of the Institution and their peers.

+ Ensure that staff are given recognition for their teaching and training activities undertaken during the mobility period, based on a mobility agreement.

- When Participating in European and International Cooperation Projects -

+ Ensure that cooperation leads to sustainable and balanced outcomes for all partners.

+ Provide relevant support to staff and students participating in these activities.

+ Exploit the results of the projects in a way that will maximise their impact on individuals and participating institutions and encourage peer learning with the wider academic community.

- For the Purposes of Visibility -

+ Display this Charter and the related Erasmus Policy Statement prominently on the Institution's website.

+ Promote consistently activities supported by the Programme, along with their results.

On behalf of the Institution, I recognise that implementation of the Charter will be monitored and that violation of any of the above principles and commitments may lead to its withdrawal by the European Commission.
