

BACHELOR'S DEGREE IN GLOBAL STUDIES GENERAL ENROLLMENT PROCEDURE 2025/2026

Dear students,

This document contains a series of guidelines to assist you in completing your enrollment for this academic year.

Please remember the following:

- You must enroll in all previously failed subjects before enrolling in new ones.
- The maximum number of credits you may enroll in per academic year is **75**.
- The minimum number of credits you must enroll in per academic year is **24**.
- You have **three exam sittings** to pass each subject (one per academic year). A "non-attendance" (**No Show**) will count as one sitting. If you wish to avoid this, you may request a withdrawal from the subject before the deadline indicated in the **2025/2026 academic and administrative calendar**.
- It is **your responsibility** to choose the subjects and groups (if more than one group is available).
- Before enrolling, please check the group timetables for each subject on the Faculty website: <https://www.udg.edu/ca/ft/Informacio-academica/Calendaris-i-horaris>

IMPORTANT:

- According to the enrollment regulations, no modifications are allowed unless there have been changes to the timetable. For this reason, it is very important that you carefully select both the subjects and, especially, the groups to avoid timetable conflicts. Pay particular attention if you are enrolling in subjects from different academic years. After completing your enrollment, you must review your timetable and make any necessary changes if you detect conflicts or errors. The self-enrollment platform allows modifications until **23:59**. After this time, no further changes will be possible. We will only accept corrections in **highly justified and exceptional cases**. A formal request must be submitted during the **incident period (July 8–24)**. Please note that we cannot guarantee a favorable response to your request. Therefore, you must check your timetable both **before and immediately after** enrolling.
- Places in subject groups and elective courses will be allocated **in the order of enrollment**. Once all places are filled, enrollment in that group will be closed.
- If you are entitled to any **exemption** (e.g., large family), it must be **valid on the day of enrollment**. If you have renewed it during the current academic year, you must upload the documentation via the *La Meva* portal (under the "Procedures" tab) **before enrolling** to avoid problems on enrollment day.
- Even if you were a scholarship holder last year, we recommend that you provide proof of any other exemptions you may be entitled to. If your scholarship application is denied, we will be able to apply the other exemption.
- **Scholarships:** We strongly recommend that you consult the **UdG Scholarship Section** website before enrolling. There you will find information on both **general scholarships** and **equity-based scholarships**: <https://www.udg.edu/ca/estudia/beques-i-ajuts/beques-de-graus>
- You may enroll under **conditional scholarship status** if you have already applied for the scholarship and meet the academic requirements.
