Academic Calendar

The Academic Year is divided into two semesters:

Winter Semester/ 1st semester: from 13 September to 18th January 2024

Spring Semester/ 2nd semester: from 5 February to 24th May 2024

The exams of the first semester take place in January and February, the exams of the second semester take place in June.

Credit System

ECTS – Each credit corresponds to 25 hours approximately of overall work by the student, including individual study, lectures, practical training, seminar, etc..

It is recommended to do between 15 and 30 credits per semester maximum.

Grading System

The Spanish Grading System ranges from 0/10 to 10/10.

The highest mark is 10/10.

Exams under 5/10 are considered as “fail/not passed”.
