Course offerings and language courses:

- Languages: While most subjects [are taught in Catalan](#), we provide a special selection of courses in English.
- Course Guide: Review the list of subjects for the academic year 2025-2026, as well as their schedules (One ECTS credit corresponds to 25 hours between lessons and the student's personal work.
- It is recommended to do between 15 and 30 credits per semester maximum).
- Schedules: Ensure to carefully check the schedules to avoid any overlapping issues.
- Apply for course in basic Catalan course to enhance your language skills (it gives you 3 ECTS and is the only course done on-line prior your arrival).

Starting dates:

- 1st Semester (Bachelor's):

Lessons: September 15, 2025, until January 16, 2026

Exam Period: January 20th, 2026, to January 31st, 2026

- 2nd Semester (Bachelor's):

Lessons: February 3, 2026, until May 30, 2026

Exam Period: June 2, 2026, to June 26, 2026

- Yearly (Master's):

Lessons: October 2, 2025, until March 2026

PAPERWORK AND DOCUMENTATION

Step 1. BEFORE YOUR ARRIVAL

Once you have been nominated by your home university and have been accepted as an incoming student [to our faculty](#), we will contact you by email with further information as soon as we have completed the nominations of all incoming students (from June 2nd, 2025).

You can do your Online Learning Agreement BEFORE through the [OLA platform/ EWP Dashboard \(ERASMUS+\)](#), and after being revised, we will sign it accordingly.

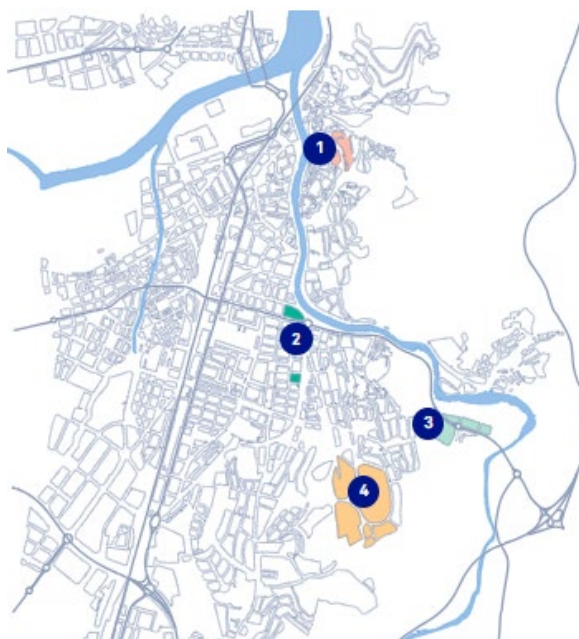

B. At your OLA you must indicate the subjects you wish to study at the Faculty of Tourism. You must inform the component code, component title, semester, and number of ECTS (subject per line).

Step 2. SELECTION OF SUBJECTS (we recommend students, before selecting the subjects, keeping the following in mind)

- We do recommend taking at least between 15 and 30 ECTS per semester maximum, so that academically it is worth the stay.
- Our academic year may be different from yours. Each semester different subjects are offered, so it is important for the student to verify that the chosen subjects are taught in the semester/s in which you came.
- Find out if our academic offer matches up with your home studies. Check the description of the course (syllabus) available on the centre's website.
- You will not be allowed to study full year subjects if you just stay one semester.
- Most of fall (1st) semester final exams are taken during January and those for the 2nd semester, in June.
- Because of the important level of saturation, we cannot guarantee a place for all students interested in a stay in all the subjects chosen in their OLA BEFORE.
- It is recommended to study subjects taught at a single center. It will be allowed to take 1 or 2 subjects from another center if they are in the same Campus and most of the subjects to be attended belong to the center where the student/university will be admitted (have a bilateral agreement).

STEP 3. ARRIVAL AT THE FACULTY OF TOURISM

- After your arrival, if you have questions regarding the courses you will follow during your stay, do not hesitate to ask your International Relations coordinator and/or made an appointment with the academic secretary.
- The Learning Agreement, which was signed before your arrival, is provisional; so, you will be able to add or modify* courses (if both your home institution coordinator and the Tourism Faculty coordinator agree).
 - Modifications of the OLA/Academic Agreement. Changes will be admitted until the 26th of September 2025.
- Remember that to enrol/register as an exchange student in the Tourism Faculty you will need to assist at the faculty session and inform the academic secretary of your arrival.

STEP 4. AT THE END OF YOUR STAY

- Before leaving the UdG / Faculty of Tourism, do not forget to:
 - Certificate of attendance/ arrival/ departure: Inform the [incoming office](#) about your arrival/ departure date and they will issue your certificate.
 - Transcript of Records: will be sent at the beginning of February (1st semester) and July (2nd semester).
 - Remember you should agree on the terms you leave your accommodation, turn in your key, and get your deposit back.
 - Close your bank account and credit cards opened during your stay.
 - Return all library books you borrowed.
