In the second stage, which is open to the public, the candidates make a brief personal presentation and then give a seminar on a topic they consider appropriate (90 minutes maximum). After the seminar, the committee will ask candidates about the qualifications listed in their *curriculum vitae*, the seminar just given or any other topic related to the contract offered and the work to be done in the position. Given the nature of the Serra Hünter Programme, this part may be conducted in English.

INDICATIONS FOR THE CANDIDATES ABOUT ORAL PRESENTATION

The candidates will give


1. A **10-minute presentation** how their research interests and research engagement and impact activities could contribute to the department and university and future plans for collaborations and grant applications within the institutional framework

2. **15-minute conference-style presentation** on a research topic linked to the profile of the position they consider appropriate
3. **20-minute teaching demonstration** linked to the profile of the position they consider appropriate. The teaching demonstration should consider the topic and the key constructs, the learning outcomes, the materials and instructional tasks to be used, the structure of the session and the interaction patterns and the assessment objectives

The selection committee will evaluate the candidates according to these criteria:

- 70%: Quality and adequacy of the presentations and the teaching demonstration given to the position (it is expected to be related with any of the topics of the job description).
- 30%: Capacity to communicate fluently and efficiently in the language of instruction and to respond to the committee members' questions and comments.
