We have two semesters, each one providing more than 30 ECTS:

- **Autumn Semester:** The lectures will start in the third week of September and continue until mid-January. The exam period will be during the last two weeks in January.
- **Spring Semester:** From the first week of February until the end of May. The exam period will be during the first two weeks in June.

We strongly recommend you arrive two weeks before the start of lectures in each semester because the External Relations Office at the UdG organises an [Introductory Course on Catalan Language and Culture](#). It is offered before the start of regular classes and lasts for two weeks. Those who attend can obtain 3 ECTS credits, and it can be included in the Learning Agreement.
