## WHAT IS BLUE & GREEN TEK?

**The Blended Intensive Programme (BIP) "Bridging Blue and Green TEK: Inclusivity and the Challenges of Social Transformation in Small-Scale Fisheries and Locally-Based Economies in Rural Areas"**

explores the transformation of small-scale communities closely linked to their ecosystems. This interdisciplinary initiative focuses on the role of Traditional Ecological Knowledge (TEK) in sustainable practices across small-scale fisheries, with a comparative outlook on pastoralism and small-scale agriculture. Participants will examine the balance between traditional knowledge and emerging Blue Economy frameworks, addressing challenges like climate change and social inclusiveness. Activities include academic seminars, workshops, fieldwork, and visits to eco-museums. The on-site component will take place along the Italian Central Adriatic coast, while the virtual phase will include preparatory lectures and case studies. The program promotes an inclusive, sustainable approach to the future of coastal and rural economies.



## FIELDWORK & ONSITE ACTIVITIES

The onsite activities will include lectures, interactive data collection and documentation activities with small-scale fishers and actors of the rural economy through a combination of roundtables, focus groups, and educational field visits. These activities are designed to create dialogical spaces where local knowledge, professional practices, and lived experiences can be shared, discussed, and critically examined.
