✓ You develop important **modern-day skills** like intercultural communication, critical thinking and global awareness, increasingly sought after by **employers** and **study-abroad** coordinators.

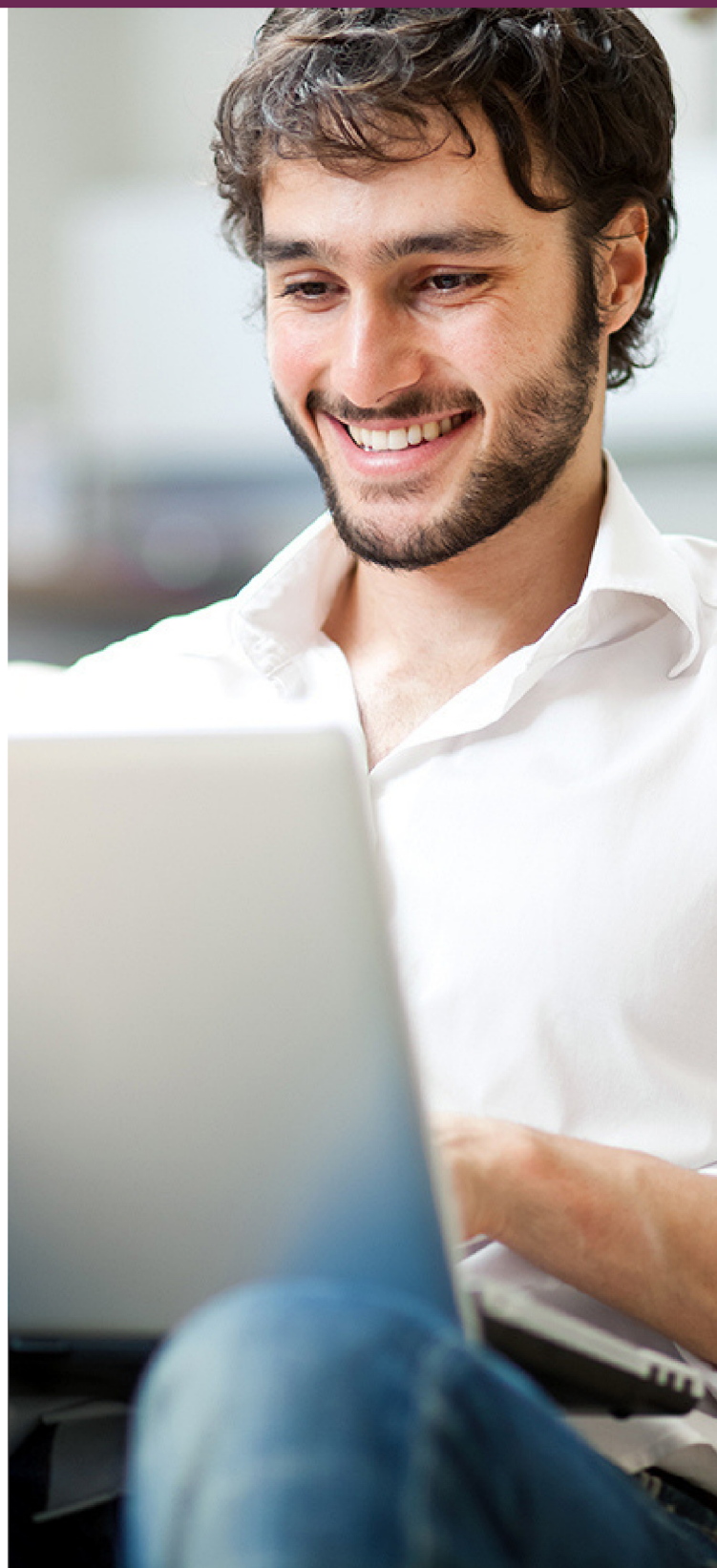
