

**RESOLUTION OF THE RECTOR EXTENDING THE DEADLINE FOR APPLICATIONS AND THE SUBMISSION OF THE COTUTELLE AGREEMENT FOR THE 2025 PUBLIC CALL FOR PROPOSALS (IFUdG2025) OF THE PROGRAM OF GRANTS FOR THE RECRUITMENT OF RESEARCH PERSONNEL IN TRAINING OF THE UNIVERSITY OF GIRONA (IFUdG2022-2024)**

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In light of the *Terms and conditions of the Programme of Grants for researchers in training of the University of Girona (2022-2024)* approved by its Governing Council in session 3/2022 on March 31, 2022, modified in session 1/2023 on January 26, 2023 and extended in session 4/2025 on April 24, 2025.

In light of the resolution of the IFUdG2025 grant call published on the UdG's electronic site on 9 May 2025, which states in point nine that the deadline for submission of applications ends on 28 May 2025 at 2:00 p.m.

In response to requests from the Université de Perpignan Via Domitia (UPVD) to allow contact between both institutions so that applications can be submitted under modality 6, as established in point four of the call.

Given that the procedure to be followed for signing the cotutelle agreement between UdG and UPVD in the event of awarding the grant under modality 6 (outlined in point 14.8 of the call and managed by the Doctoral School) has proven to have an insufficient submission deadline.

Considering that contact between UdG and UPVD is initiated at the time of application to open the possibility of a joint thesis, and that applicants under modality 6 must submit a certificate from UPVD stating that the thesis co-supervisor from their institution meets the required conditions.

In light of the foregoing facts and foundations of law, by virtue of Royal Decree 401/20217, of 14 December (Official Journal of the Government of Catalonia [DOGC] no. 8564, of 16 December 2021), appointing the rector of the University of Girona, and in accordance with the provisions of Articles 93 and 97 of the Statutes of the University of Girona, approved by Agreement GOV/94/2011, of 7 June, (DOGC no. 5897, of 09 June 2011);

In accordance with the aforementioned, the present agreement for the public call for places and grants is approved.

**I HEREBY RESOLVE:**

**First.** To extend the application deadline for the 2025 call of the UdG Programme for the recruitment of research personnel in training (IFUdG2025) until **4 June 2025 at 2:00 p.m.** Applications must be submitted through the corresponding [electronic form](#). If the application is not automatically registered due to use of an incompatible identifier, the generated PDF must be electronically signed and submitted via the [UdG's electronic registry](#) within the same deadline.

**Second.** To extend the deadline for submitting the cotutelle agreement between UdG and UPVD, requiring at the time of aid acceptance a report on the current status of the agreement.

Against this resolution, which exhausts administrative remedies and is immediately enforceable, interested parties may file an optional appeal for reconsideration with the rector of the University of Girona within one month from the day following notification, in accordance with articles 123 and 124 of Law 39/2015, of 1 October, on common administrative procedure; or they may directly file a contentious-administrative appeal before the contentious-administrative courts of Girona within two months from the day following notification, pursuant to articles 8.3, 14.1, and 46.1 of Law 29/1998, of 13 July, regulating the contentious-administrative jurisdiction.

Likewise, interested parties may file any other appeal they deem appropriate for the defense of their interests.
