

RESOLUTION OF THE RECTOR CORRECTING THE CRITERIA ESTABLISHED BY MODALITY 6, FOR THE 2025 PUBLIC CALL (IFUdG2025) OF THE GRANT PROGRAMME FOR THE RECRUITMENT OF RESEARCH PERSONNEL IN TRAINING OF THE UNIVERSITAT DE GIRONA (IFUdG2022-2024)

In light of the *Terms and conditions of the Programme of Grants for researchers in training of the Universitat de Girona (2022-2024)* approved by Governing Council of UdG in session 3/2022 on March 31, 2022, modified in session 1/2023 on January 26, 2023, and extended in session 4/2025 on April 24, 2025.

In light of the resolution of the IFUdG2025 grant call published on the UdG's electronic site on 9 May 2025 and the modification published on 25 May 2025.

In light of the provisions of section 3.4.3 regarding the specific requirements that each call must establish for grants under modality 6.

In light of the additional requirements for category 6, in agreement with the Université Via Domitia in Perpignan, established in point 2.2 of the call for candidates and thesis supervisors, and the absence of requirements for research groups.

Having considered the arguments presented and by virtue of the powers conferred upon me by Articles 105 and 109 of the Statutes of the University of Girona (Agreement GOV/200/2025, of 29 July, approving the Statutes of the University of Girona - DOGC No. 9467, of 31 July 2025-), and by Decree 401/2021, of 14 December, appointing Dr Joaquim Salvi Mas as Rector of the Universitat de Girona (DOGC no. 8564, of 16 December 2021).

I HEREBY RESOLVE,

First. To establish that for application for modality 6 grants, research groups are not required to meet any requirements and that only the candidate will be evaluated, in accordance with the provisions of point 1 of the annex to the regulatory bases.

Second. To order the publication of this resolution on the notice board of the Universitat de Girona's electronic headquarters <https://seu.udg.edu/serveis-dinformacio/tauler-danuncis-electronic>.

Against this resolution, which puts an end to the administrative process and regardless of its immediate execution, interested parties may, at their discretion, lodge an appeal for reconsideration with the Rector of the Universitat de Girona within one month from the day following its notification, in accordance with the provisions of Articles 123 and 124 of Law 39/2015, of 1 October, on common administrative procedure; or directly lodge an administrative appeal before the administrative courts of Girona within two months from the day following notification, in accordance with Articles 8.3, 14.1 and 46.1 of Law 29/1998, of 13 July, regulating administrative jurisdiction.

Likewise, interested parties may file any other appeal they deem appropriate to defend their interests.
