

RESOLUTION OF RECTOR, OF 17 SEPTEMBER 2020, ON ADOPTING EXTRAORDINARY MEASURES TO CONTAIN COVID-19

Given the epidemiological situation in the cities of Girona and Salt, which has led to the adoption of specific measures for these areas (Resolution SLT/2230/2020, of 15 September, of the Ministry of Health of the Government of Catalonia , adopting special public health measures to contain the epidemic outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic in the municipalities of Girona and Salt); and carefully considering the risks of transmission and the impact on academic activity that may occur, it is considered appropriate to suspend formal face-to-face graduation, academic, academic-year inauguration, honorary doctorate and award ceremonies or other similar events.

This measure is taken following the recommendations and proposals of the Monitoring Committee established in the Contingency Plan of the University of Girona, plan approved by agreement of the Governing Council in ordinary session no. 6/2020, of 23 July.

For all these reasons, and in accordance with Articles 93 and 97.1, paragraph a), of the Statutes of the University of Girona (Agreement GOV/94/2011, of 7 June, published in the Official Gazette of the Government of Catalonia (DOGC) no. 5897, of 9 June 2011); and in accordance with Royal Decree 1065/2017, of 22 December, appointing the rector of the University of Girona (BOE no. 316, of 29 December 2017),

I RESOLVE:

One. To temporarily suspend the celebration of formal face-to-face ceremonies (graduation, academic, academic-year inauguration, honorary doctorate, award or other similar events) of the University of Girona.

Two. To publish this resolution in the Official Gazette of the University of Girona.

This resolution exhausts the right of appeal through administrative channels. Independently of its immediate enforceability, and in accordance with Articles 123 and 124 of Law 39/2015, of 1 October, regulating common administrative procedures, interested persons may file an administrative appeal against this resolution with the rector of the University of Girona within one month of the day after the decision is made public; or to file an administrative appeal directly against this resolution with the administrative law court of Girona within two months of the day after the decision is made public, as established in Articles 8.3, 14.1 and 46.1 of Law 29/1998, of 13 July, regulating contentious-administrative jurisdiction of the administrative courts.

Likewise, interested persons may also file any other appeal they consider appropriate to defend their interests.
