Exchange students have access to a selection of **subjects taught in English**, together with local students and under the same conditions as the UdG students. We have two semesters, each one providing a total of 30 ECTS points:

- **Autumn Semester:** The lectures will start in the third week of September and continue until mid-January. The exam period will be during the last two weeks in January.
- **Spring Semester:** From the first week of February until the end of May. The exam period will be during the first two weeks in June.
- However, **we strongly recommend** you arrive two weeks before the start of lectures in each semester because the External Relations Office at the UdG organises an **Introductory Course on Catalan Language and Culture**. It is offered before the start of regular classes and lasts for two weeks. Those who attend can obtain 3 ECTS credits, and it can be included in the Learning Agreement.
